

Windows Vista Internet Connection Setup

Requirements:

- Windows Vista
- Working Dial up modem – 14400 bps or higher

Click **“Start”**

From the **“Control Panel”**

Click **“Network and Internet”**

Click **“Network and Sharing Center”**

Click **“Set up a connection or network”**

Click on **“Set up a dial-up connection”**.

Choose the modem that you want to use from the list that appears on the screen. If there are no modems listed then you either do not have a modem installed on your computer or your modem is not installed properly.

Type the following information in the appropriate fields:

- **Dial-up phone number:** Enter the phone number to be dialed: 6526480
- **User name:** Type your username
- **Password:** Type your password. Place a check in the box next to "Remember this password" if you don't want to type it every time that you connect.
- **Connection name:** Enter a name for the connection: WNC Online

Note: if you have call waiting, temporarily disable it when you are connecting to the Internet by using **“*70,,6526480”** as the phone number.

Click **“Connect”** to create and save the connection. If your computer is not currently plugged into a phone jack, the connection will fail, but you can click **“Set up the connection anyway”** to save the connection for future use.
